



GamCare CCBT Software Specification

February 2019

Background:

The Gambling Commission's 2016 Combined Health Survey estimates that there are around 340,000 problem gamblers, and a further 1.75 million at risk in Great Britain. GamCare is commissioned by GambleAware to be the leading provider of information, advice and support for the prevention and treatment of problem gambling. We operate the National Gambling Helpline, provide treatment for problem gamblers and their families, both directly and via a partner network, raise awareness about safer gambling and the support available, and encourage an effective approach to safer gambling within the gambling industry.

In 2017/18 GamCare received around 30,000 calls to the HelpLine and around 8,000 people accessed one to one or group treatment either face to face or online. In addition, around 25,000 people completed a 'self-assessment tool' on our website, of whom 80% screened as problem gamblers.

There is a clear gap between the number of people who would benefit from support and the number of people receiving it. Our new strategy was published in April 2018, and within this we stated that we will diversify our offer, delivering a more holistic service that fully reflects the range of impacts experienced by our beneficiaries. Linked to this, we will continue to measure the effectiveness, outcomes and impacts of our work, publishing this information annually. Both will contribute to increased numbers accessing treatment.

GamCare currently uses Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) in its model of care in the treatment of problem gambling. We provide problem gamblers with a range of CBT based support options, which include access to treatment support online, via telephone and in person face-to-face. Offering choice to service users is an important part of this, and computerised CBT (CCBT) would be consistent with our overarching CBT based model of care. It would provide a further development to our existing online skype/zoom based one to one and group work. CCBT is widely used in mental health service to treat depression and anxiety and is seen as a cost-effective alternative to face to face treatment.

For these reasons, we are keen to explore CCBT within the problem gambling cohort.

CCBT Development

Digital screening is already available via www.gamcare.org.uk, but the addition of digital brief interventions and a computerised version of CBT, known as CCBT, offers the opportunity for 'end to end' digital care pathways, supplemented by practitioner support.

The proposed new digital intervention service has two elements:

1. The addition of brief intervention modules to the existing screening tool on the GamCare website. This will increase the structured support available to this cohort and encourage help seeking. In addition, these tools will be available to helpline staff to share with callers via an email link and provide call backs to discuss the interventions. The brief interventions take an average of 10 minutes to complete.

2. The development of computerised CBT (CCBT), complemented by therapist call backs. This is in line with the evidence base around CCBT, which suggested that attrition is significantly reduced if contact with a therapist, even of short duration, is offered between sessions.

Separately from this ITT for software, GamCare will recruit therapists to work with the CCBT software and will ensure that the software is appropriately marketed to reach as wide an audience as possible.

CCBT Software Specification:

GamCare are seeking to procure a software package to deliver end to end digital interventions. This will include:

1. Provision of digital screening for problem gambling using a validated screening tool such as PGSI or equivalent
2. Provision of brief intervention modules of up to 15 minutes which will be recommended based on the outcome of screening and which can also be used as standalone modules by our helpline team
3. Provision of CCBT of up to 10 sessions, each with a minimum duration of 20 minutes, maximum duration 1 hour.
4. Provision of data and analytics to ensure we can monitor individual characteristics, progress, attrition, outcomes and follow ups for all participants in the programme.

The software must have the following characteristics:

- Be explicitly applicable to problem gambling
- Be integrated to provide an 'end to end' digital pathway
- Be evidence based, demonstrably rooted in CBT methodology
- Be evaluated by a third party and be demonstrably effective in achieving lasting change. Longer term follow-up must be included in the evidence base
- Be able to collect a data set (see appendix 1) to facilitate monitoring of outcomes
- Be able to assess suitability for CCBT based on screening/registration characteristics
- Be able to provide comprehensive data analytics across the cohort as well as for case management purposes
- Be able to flag safeguarding or other concerns arising from a CCBT session so therapist contact can be prioritised
- Be able to schedule long term follow ups digitally
- Integrate with our website
- Ideally, integrate with our case management systems

Finances:

The budget available for the software, inclusive of all elements, start-up costs and support, is £30,000 annually.

Submissions will be evaluated with a weighting of 70% on quality and 30% on pricing information. Organisational information will be assessed.
